Our New Town Website Is Live

Sound Financial Management

The Town Board continues to emphasize fiscal responsibility. Capital projects such as building renovations and equipment purchases are handled separately from day-to-day operating budgets to keep our finances clear and accountable. Escrow accounts are also used for major development projects to ensure proper oversight of non-taxpayer funds.
